Peter J. Grant, MD, FMedSci

Peter Grant is Professor of Medicine and Diabetologist in the Faculty of Medicine and Health and has a particular interest in the management of vascular risk in patients with diabetes. His research focuses on understanding the molecular basis of the strong biological link between diabetes and cardiovascular (CV) disease, in particular the genetic and environmental determinants of thrombotic risk in relation to insulin resistance and CV disease. He has published over 200 original research articles in peer-reviewed journals including *Diabetes, Blood, Circulation* and *The Lancet* with an H-index of 61.

Professor Grant is founder and Editor-in-Chief of the international journal, *Diabetes and Vascular Disease Research*, a peer reviewed journal that publishes research that links these two conditions. Professor Grant was joint chair of the ESC/EASD guidelines committee (2010-13) on cardiovascular disease prevention and management in diabetes which published the guidelines in the *European Heart Journal* in September 2013. He is currently co-chair for the 2017-19 revision of the guidelines, representing the EASD. He is a fellow of the European Society of Cardiology and a Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences
